## 5D4N MM2H Inspection Tour + Fun in Kuala Lumpur City



### Day 1 : Home / Kuala Lumpur (3.5hrs) (Dinner& show)

Upon arrival, meet & transfer to respective hotel for check in. In the evening, proceed for a tour which introduces you to the Malaysian way of life. Mingle with the locals at a bustling Chinatown & enjoy a potpourri of different Malaysian cultural performances while tucking in a sumptuous Malay buffet dinner & cultural show.

### Day 2 – MM2H Inspection Tour + ½ Day Putrajaya Garden City Tour (B)

After breakfast, proceed by coach to attend MM2H Seminar (2 hrs), this seminar will brief you on the procedures or application process to obtain Government’s approval of social visit pass, the seminar will also present to you some of the new development properties surrounding Kuala Lumpur, Petaling Jaya and/or Putrajaya Garden city. Our first stop will be Taman Warisan or Agricultural Heritage Park – a ‘living’ museum for mango, rubber, coca, palm oil, durian, jackfruit, herbs and etc. A demonstration on the entire rubber-manufacturing process from the time it is tapped and churned out as fully smoked sheets will be shown during the tour.

Next proceed to Putra Jaya Government Centre, there are numerous new government complexes located in this new township. The most imposing structure in Putrajaya is the thin pinkish Putra Mosque. Standing beside Dataran Putra and facing the Putrajaya Lake, it incorporates architectural elements from Turkestan, Kazakhstan and Morocco. Another eye-catching building is the Prime Minister’s office – Putra Perdana. Other interesting places are Putra Bridge, Prime Minister’s residence.

### Day 3 : Countryside/City Tour (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed for a tour which you could have a chance to see the beauty & intrigue of Kuala Lumpur in one sweep. This tour gives you a colorful spectrum of Malaysian architecture, history, culture, heritage, crafts & lifestyle. Among the highlights of the tour are The National Monument, The King’s Palace, The National Museum, The National Mosque, The Independence Square, The Sultan Abdul Samad Building, The Petronas Twin Towers & Royal Selangor Pewter Factory.

### Day 4 : Genting Highlands Day Tour (B)

After breakfast, proceed for a destination where you could get a reprieve from the humidity city – Genting Highlands, a popular tourist place situated over 1,700 meters above sea level. Genting Highlands offers contemporary & traditional attractions like an international casino, a family theme park, temples, a man-made lake, parks & a golf resort.

Check out from hotel and transfer to airport for flight back home.
